

Timebanking The Basics - Managing Expectations & Implementing Models


This session will cover what timebanking can and cannot do for your communities and individuals, managing the community expectations and exploring 3 models of timebanking.



This session is for people new to the time bank co-ordinating role and will offer guidance and advice on the essential aspects to consider when setting up your time bank.




A Guide To Grant Funding

In this session we will look at the various safeguarding features that exist within TOL2 and how we should ensure safeguarding for time bank members.




Information Governance for Time Banks


